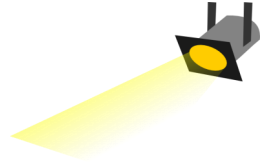
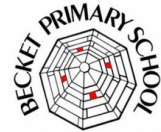


## Staff spotlight



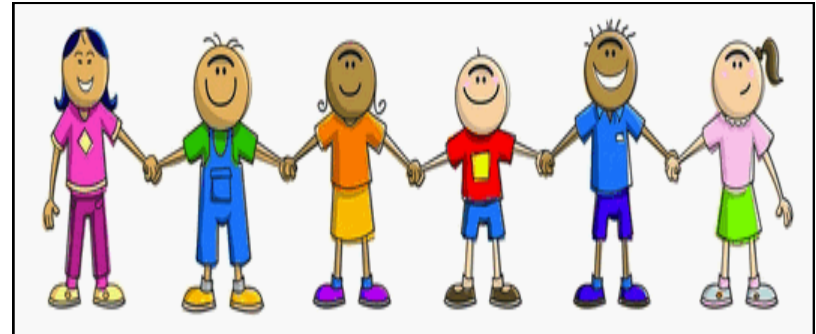

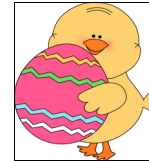
This half-term
