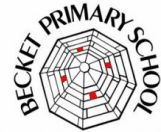


Staff spotlight

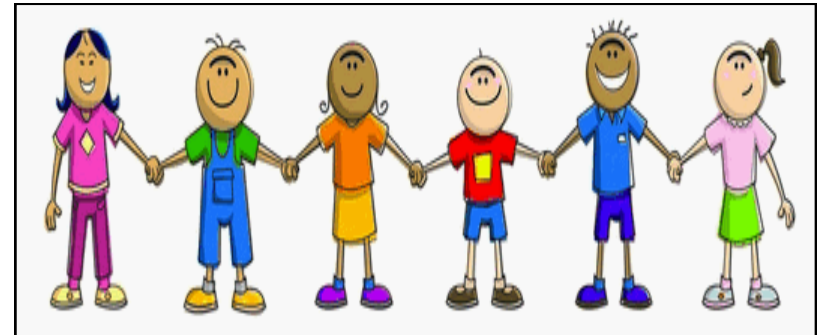

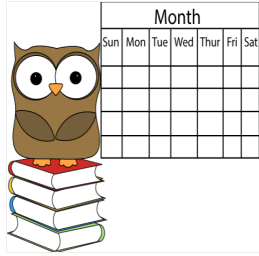
