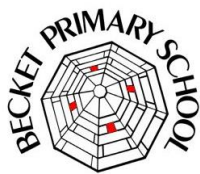

Charging and Remissions Policy

Issues	Policy
Residential courses in School Term Time.	Parents are required to meet the full cost. Where the cost prohibits a child taking part, individual cases may be subsidised at the discretion of the Governing Body.
Non residential school trips.	Parents/ carers are requested to pay a voluntary contribution towards the trip but no child must be disadvantaged because of parents' inability/ reluctance to pay.
Visiting groups within school time as part of the National Curriculum (e.g theatre and curriculum groups)	Parents/ carers are requested to pay a voluntary contribution towards the cost but no child must be disadvantaged because of parents' inability/ reluctance to pay.
Activities outside school hours not within the National Curriculum.	Parents to meet full cost unless the activity is subsidised by the Pupil Premium.
Music Tuition	Up to and including grade 1 is provided free by school as part of the National Curriculum in music.
Music exams	Grade 1 exam fees paid by school. Grade 2 exams and above charged to parents.
Lost school equipment, books etc	Parents may be expected to replace or pay for the lost item.
Breakages and damages to school buildings, furniture or property.	Where wilful damage has occurred parents will be expected to make a contribution to the cost of repair.
Ingredients/ materials for practical subjects,	School to meet the cost.
Late collection of a child from Nursery or school.	Where children have been collected more than fifteen minutes late without prior warning, parents may be charged a late pick up fee of £3 per child.
Child care / Extended Schools	After School and Breakfast club costs are met in full by parents. Individual cases may be subsidised at the discretion of the Governing Body.
School Meals	Parents are required to meet the full cost (unless claiming Free School Meals). Individual cases may be subsidised at the discretion of the Governing Body.
Pupil Premium	Individual cases for subsidy to be used at discretion of Governing Body.
