

In the academic year 2016/17 we will receive £8500 of funding from the P.E and Sport Grant Allocation. This funding will be spent to support the following aims:

At Becket Primary School we aim to:

	Cost	Impact
Gym Club coach and weekly gym session for children in key stage one	1500	Sessions run throughout the year with consistency of attendees. We give the opportunity for different children to sign up each half term and we are always full. The gym club helps the young children with their co-ordination and gross motor skills. 50 children regularly accessed this club throughout progressing through the gymnastics proficiency awards.
Fencing and Archery club Parkour club Handball	900	Different cohorts of children being given the opportunity to participate in unusual sports.
Weekly Street Dance Club led by qualified dance coach from DEDA for children in Upper Keystage 2, lower key stage 2 and Key stage 1. D3 project for KS2. Collaboration with Déda youth and undergraduate dancers	1000	Fifth year of our collaboration with Deda. 20 year 2 children undertook a 4 week dance module culminating in a shared performance to peers. Children displayed increased confidence, self-esteem and love of dance. A high percentage of these children progress to KS2 dance sessions; more challenging routines in a high grade professional venue alongside undergraduates.
Subsidising whole school visit to Deda to see live dance performances including those featuring fellow pupils.	400	Curriculum enrichment. Opportunities to experience original, contemporary dance pieces by renowned choreographers.

The 24 of the year 6 children learned roadcraft and rode confidently on the roads around school. Cyclo-Cross – opportunity to participate competitively in a different type of cycling which is not generally available. Track sessions – 15 of the year 6 children all progressed up to the blue line and beyond on the Derby Arena cycle track.</p>
