

In the academic year 2017/18 we will receive £17100 of funding form the P.E and Sport Grant Allocation. This funding will be spent to support the following aims:

At Becket Primary School we aim to:

Gym Club coach and weekly gym session for children in key stage one and key stage 2	3500	Sessions run throughout the year with consistency of attendees. We give the opportunity for different children to sign up each half term and we are always full. The KS1 gym club helps the young children with their coordination, gross motor skills and confidence. This year we have introduced a KS2 gym club to progress the children through the gymnastics proficiency awards that they have achieved in the KS1 club. The cohort attending these clubs are different to the cohort attending the more traditional sports clubs and are predominantly girls.
